# **Writing Prompt**

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Social Media and Self-Esteem: Has it Created a More Insecure Youth?

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> Pop Culture Grades 9-12



## Introduction

Social media and self-esteem have become intertwined in our society. Social media has given teens the instant ability to connect with others; however, teens must also contend with pressure to look and act in certain ways. In this writing prompt, students will share their thoughts on the question: "Has social media created a more insecure youth?" as well as provide relevant and sufficient evidence to back their reasoning.

# Learning Objectives

<u>CCSS.ELA-Literacy.W.9-10.1</u>. Students will write arguments to support claims in an analysis of substantive topics or texts, using valid reasoning and relevant and sufficient evidence

### Materials Needed

· Paper and pencil

### Procedure

- 1. Tell students that experts say that kids growing up today have more anxiety and lower self-esteem because of the constant pressures of social media and pop culture. Then, ask students if they think that social media has created a more insecure youth and why they think that.
- 2. Tell students that today they will be writing an essay explaining their reasoning. Students can read articles online to help with their essay; however, they must use relevant and sufficient evidence to back up their point of view.

### **Evaluation**

Students will be assessed on how well they followed the guidelines for the writing prompt. Essays should have the following components:

- · Introduction with a thesis statement
- $\cdot$  Three supporting paragraphs that include facts and information collected during research
- Conclusion
- · Well organized, good flow, and free of grammatical and spelling errors
